SCUBA DIVING CAMP

Max 20 Places: This exciting camp will be run by the professional staff from Dive Zone, Whitianga and involves online learning, pool sessions and 6-8 ocean dives. Students will receive the PADI Open Water Certificate and 13 unit standard credits at Level 3. ***Do not choose this camp if you have or have had asthma. You must also pass a swimming test to get on the list!***



MOUNTAIN BIKING CAMP

Max 14 Places: Staying at the Rotorua Thermal Holiday park and riding full suspension Mountain Bikes from "Mountain Bike Rotorua", in the Whakarewarewa Forest (Redwoods), this camp will be action packed including some rider skills coaching from NZOIA MTB2 qualified coach to help you get the best out of your time on the trails. **Good level of fitness needed.**



SURFING CAMP

Max 19 Places: *Designed for both students who have never surfed before and those with their own board and some experience. We provide large foamy boards for those learning to surf up to 12 students. Raglan Surf school instruction for all students on the first day then surfing Raglan and Ruapuke beach for the remainder of the camp. Food is fully catered for. Only 12* **Learner Boards – best if you have your own. Being able to swim 50m in open ocean essential!**



GEOCASHING CAMP

Max 20 Places: Geocaching is a global treasure hunt in which participants use GPS enabled smartphones and/ or handheld GPS units to find hidden containers. We use Geocaching as a means to motivate students to take part in a wide range of activities that include; **Biking** from Waihi to Paeroa through the Karangahake gorge (Hauraki Rail Trail), **Kayaking** to Whenuakura/ Donut Island **or paddle boarding** up the Whangamata estuary (weather dependant), walking up and around Mount Maunganui, spending an afternoon at **Baywave** and completing a number of **short walks** such as the Wentworth Valley falls and Martha Pitt Rim walks. we will be staying at the SeaEsta Lodge in Waihi
