1 Pastoral Care - Students receive wrap-around care from our international team, Counsellors, Subject Teachers, and Deans. Students can contact an advisor anytime if they need assistance or support.

2 Insurance provided by UniCare. Students will be charged the actual cost based on the number of days in NZ, including travel to/from their home country. Therefore, this cost may adjust slightly based on this.

3 Prepaid School Expenses typically cover students' stationery, trips, activities, and extracurricular activities (e.g., sporting or cultural choices). If the student's account falls below \$50, parents will be invoiced for further activity choices that year.

ADDITIONAL COSTS MAY INCLUDE

1. Homestay change fee (per instance): \$350 – this additional fee may be charged if a student wishes to change their homestay.

2. Leaver's documentation fee: \$150

3. Uniform costs: Need approximately \$750 (Short-term, less than one term or specially agreed term, students wear their home country school uniforms or borrow basic second-hand uniform (\$80); long-term students need to bring cash or credit cards to purchase the uniforms)- Uniform information: [Uniform Expectations](#)

4. Bring money for taking public transportation to and from the homestay and other places.

6. Pocket money

To study effectively at St John's College, pack essentials like academic materials (textbooks, notebooks, pens, etc.), a laptop or tablet. Additionally, pack appropriate clothing for varying weather conditions, as New Zealand can experience four seasons in one day.

Here's a more detailed list:

Academic Essentials:

- **Stationery:** Pack pens, pencils, highlighters, erasers, a ruler, and a pencil case.
- **Notebooks:** Please bring notebooks or binders to take notes in class.
- **Laptop/Tablet:** A laptop or tablet is crucial for research, assignments, and online learning.
- **Charger and Power Bank:** Make sure you have chargers for all your devices and a power bank for on-the-go charging.
- **Wear uniforms:** Long-term students wear the St John's uniform. Short-term students (less than 1 term) can wear their home country school uniform.

Other Useful Items:

- **Backpack or School Bag:** A comfortable backpack or school bag to carry your belongings.
- **Water Bottle:** Staying hydrated is important, so bring a reusable water bottle.

- **Lunch and Snacks:** Pack some healthy snacks to keep you energized throughout the day.
- **Personal Items:** Don't forget any personal items like toiletries, medications, or any other items you may need.
